The Navajo County Hashknife Sheriff's Posse is holding a golf tournament. All profits will benefit the non-profit, all volunteer, Navajo County Hashknife Sheriff's Posse.

The Navajo County Hashknife Sheriff's Posse is one of the best mounted search and rescue teams in the state of Arizona. The Posse is also the oldest officially sanctioned Pony Express in the world. The Hashknife Pony Express makes its ride every January traveling 200 miles from Holbrook to Scottsdale, Arizona, delivering 20,000 first-class letters by horseback. The ride is led by the Navajo County Hashknife Sheriff's Posse. More than two dozen riders in authentic cowboy clothing carry the mail, relaying the bags along the route. The arrival of the Hashknife Pony Express in Scottsdale kicks off the annual Parada del Sol.
